Dear colleagues,

We look forward to a possibility to welcome you in person in Munich in September, if measures at the time allow for the in-person meeting at our University. For yours and our safety, we have compiled the information about *current* measures in force at the LMU. We assure you that we are monitoring the situation closely, and we encourage you to frequently check links listed below, especially if you plan to travel to Munich from abroad. Situation can change in the last minute, and we all hope for the better. There is, however, a possibility that rules may be different closer to the dates planned for our meeting (14-16. September, 2021).

The rules to prevent COVID-19 spread are simple and follow “good practices” concept that many of us are familiar with, also from our work in the vaccinology area. Please consider the following before your travel:

Entry to Germany is restricted, based on the [current estimate of COVID-19 risk](#):

The quarantine requirement does not apply to those:

- Who have been fully vaccinated (final vaccination at least 14 days prior to entry),
- Who have recovered (min. 28 days, max. 6 months prior to entry),
- With a negative rapid test (antigen test; max. 48 h prior to entry, if entering from a virus variant area max. 24 h prior to entry) or PCR test (max. 72 h prior to entry).

Most current information about the risk areas and travel restrictions from abroad or within Germany can be found at the websites of [Robert Koch Institute](#), [German Government Travel Advisory](#) and [Bavarian Government](#) COVID-19 web pages. [Current LMU rules](#) are also quickly updated to reflect changes in the federal, state and local government regulations.

Face Mask wearing is compulsory at LMU-Munich:

All LMU visitors are required to wear a FFP2 facemask on LMU premises (indoors and outdoors). This includes but is not limited to any lecture halls, conference rooms, and in all areas of LMU buildings where people meet, or come in contact with others. This applies in particular to corridors, stairways, elevators and bathrooms.

It is possible to meet under specific hygiene measures:

In accordance of the Bavarian Ordinance on Infection Control, since 7 June 2021, in-person classes and meetings are permitted in compliance with special hygiene measures, the minimum of 1,5

meters social distance and mandatory face mask-wearing. If the seven-day incidence exceeds 50, a negative Covid-19 test result is required twice a week.

However, persons are not allowed to enter the university if they:

- have knowingly had contact with a confirmed COVID-19 patient (close contact according to RKI) within the last 14 days, unless otherwise directed by the public health department
- show symptoms that may indicate COVID-19 disease, such as respiratory symptoms of any severity, unspecific general symptoms, and olfactory or gustatory disturbances;
- are obliged to be placed in domestic quarantine in accordance with the currently valid entry regulation (see links above).

We are excited to provide the opportunity for in-person meetings once again after long hiatus and hope that above information will help you and us to stay safe and healthy.
